ABOUT GET REDRESSED MONTH



Every day, Hong Kong sends a staggering **402 tonnes of textile waste to our landfills.**

Since its launch in 2018, Get Redressed Month has been mobilising organisations and the public to reduce clothing waste. This year, we offer companies and universities to join **3 key activities** that engage your team and the public in meaningful actions:

1. CLOTHING DRIVE

Redress will deliver and pick up clothing collection boxes to and from your venue(s), giving your community an easy way to drop off unwanted clothing and give them a new life.

2. THE DENIM CHALLENGE

A game-based, team-building learning session that enables participants to gain a deeper understanding of the impact of the fashion industry.

3. SORT-A-THON

Clothes collected from the Clothing Drive will be carefully sorted and categorised for recirculation. During this activity you will join 400+ participants to sort clothes in a fun atmosphere.

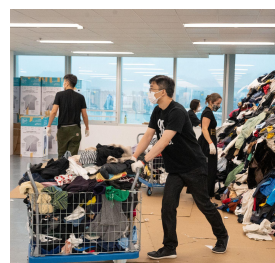
WHY JOIN GET REDRESSED MONTH?

1. CLOTHING DRIVE

In May, simply place the provided clothing collection boxes in a visible area where items can be **easily dropped off by your community**.

- Be part of a city-wide campaign to collect and recirculate unwanted clothes, making fashion more circular
- For every 2 boxes your organisation signs up for, **Redress will provide 2 FREE boxes** to a school

Redress will provide:

- Boxes delivery by the last week of April 2026 and pickup the first week of June 2026
- Boxes that are designed to indicate what clothing items are accepted and where the collected clothing will go
- A poster to help you promote the clothing drive
- A factsheet on the environmental impact of the fashion industry

Last year, **166** collection points participated in the clothing drive.

2. THE DENIM CHALLENGE

Explore the complex realities of clothing manufacturing and **learn about the impact of the fashion industry.**

Step into the shoes of an industry stakeholder and **collaborate with team members** to carefully weigh the social, environmental and economic impact of each decision - from raw materials to manufacturing processes. You will then defend your position and make your voice heard to get the best 'deal' with the other players.

A great team activity held at your offices, where participants will discuss and navigate the difficult balance between economic goals and environmental responsibility, **rethinking how clothing is produced and consumed.**

- A fun way to learn while building team rapport
- In Cantonese or English
- Interactive and team-oriented
- Up to 30 participants
- Facilitated by Redress, in-person only



3. SORT-A-THON

Clothing collected through the Clothing Drive must be carefully sorted into categories before being **recirculated**. This large-scale sorting event calls for all hands on deck to ensure the items **have the best chance at a new life**.

- 3-hour volunteering activity filled with purpose
- High level of interaction and engagement
- Max. 12 participants per team
- Be part of 400+ company volunteers
- Play a vital role in supporting local charities

- Full operation management
- Provide refreshments, music, and fun games!

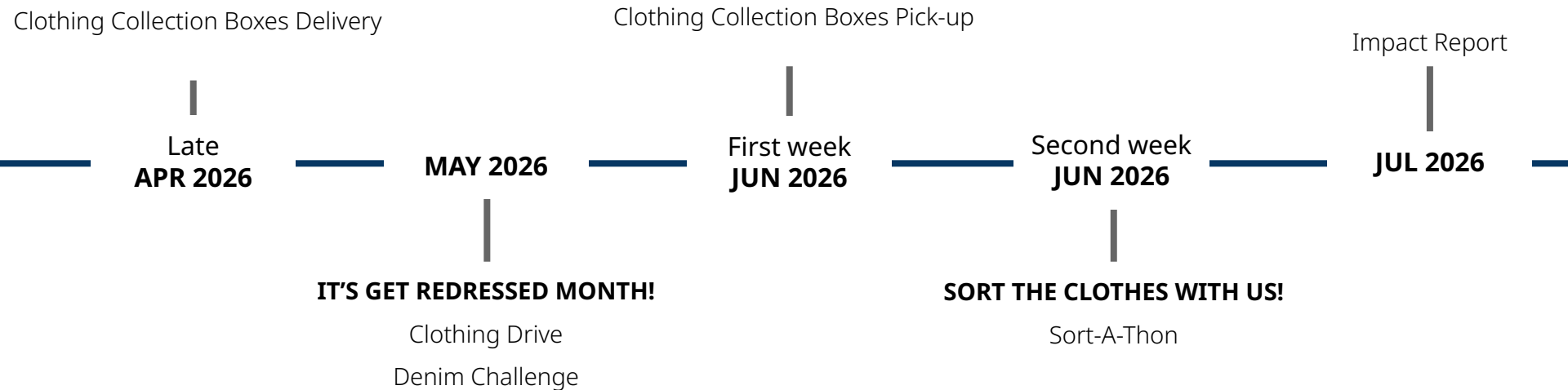

Accelerating the change to a circular fashion industry by educating and empowering designers and consumers

We are a Hong Kong-based, Asia-focused environmental NGO on a mission to accelerate the transition to a circular fashion industry by educating and empowering designers and consumers, in order to reduce clothing's negative environmental impacts.

We work with consumers, designers, brands, manufacturers, research institutions, schools, nonprofits, government, and corporations to explore and promote better ways to design, produce, purchase, reuse, and recycle clothing.

Clothing Drive:

Can we know more about the delivery and pickup of the collection boxes?

Boxes will be delivered to your venue(s) last week of April 2026 and picked up by the first week of June 2026. Our team will email you the exact dates of delivery and pick-up in late March 2026.

What will Redress provide for the clothing drive?

- The production, delivery, and pickup of the clothing collection boxes, which are designed to indicate what clothing items are accepted and where the collected clothing will go
- An update on the quantity your organisation has collected (shared in June)
- A poster to help you promote the clothing drive
- A factsheet to provide knowledge about the environmental impact of the fashion industry

Where will the clothes go?

Items collected will be sorted into different categories at the Sort-a-Thon event. After they are carefully checked, they'll be redistributed: 50%-60% will be given to local charities, 20-30% will be downcycled, 10%-15% will be resold at our pop-up/shops. Only damaged non-textile items (broken shoes, plastic bags, etc) will go to landfill, which represents less than 4%.

What about clothes that cannot be reused?

Clothes that have reached the end of their 'wearable' life (e.g. used personal items like underwear, socks, sleepwear, and swimwear, or really worn out/stained/damaged items), or clothes that our charity partners don't want (e.g. company/school uniforms), are difficult for us to deal with. Globally, including in Hong Kong, there is a lack of viable recycling technologies to deal with these 'bottom layer' clothes at scale. At the moment, Redress is working with a partner in Hong Kong to *downcycle* these items, by shredding the materials and using them to produce boxing bags (to be sent to Thailand boxing schools). Metal pieces (zipper, buttons) are removed at the shredding process to be recycled separately. Each boxing bag requires approximately 40-50 kg of shredded materials. We also send some unwearable to HKRITA to support the development of their Green Machine, which allows fibre-to-fibre recycling for blended textiles.

Sort-a-Thon:

I would like to volunteer at the Sort-A-Thon as an individual. How can I sign up?

Individual volunteer sign-ups will open in May 2026, please stay tuned! Individual volunteers are so important to help us run the event smoothly, please note that their role will be to help with the logistics and running of the event, whereas the corporate volunteers will take care of the clothing sorting.

Can we have more than 12 per team for Sort-a-thon?

Can I bring my children to Sort-a-Thon?

Children are encouraged to participate in Get Redressed Month activities through their schools. The Denim Challenge and Sort-a-Thon are for participants over 18 years old only.

Where do the participation fees go?

Company/organisations participation fees cover the operational costs of running Get Redressed Month, and help provide primary and secondary schools with free participation in the Get Redressed Month activities.

Which charities do you work with?

The majority of wearable items are redistributed to our network of 20+ local charity partners for reuse by their beneficiaries, including Crossroads, Caritas, YWCA, ImpactHK, Christian Action, and many more.
